

## **GUIDELINES FOR PLAYING AT OUR CLUB**

**Days of Play** Monday and Thursday at the Town Centre Greytown

**Hours of Play** 6.30pm – players should be seated by 6.20 ready to play at 6.30

**Monday Nights** All club members are welcome to play but at least one member of each pair must be graded Junior or Novice except for any “Draw for Partner” nights

**Thursday Night** Club members can play with anyone of any grade

**Partners Normally** players arrange their own partners. This can be difficult to do sometimes, particularly if you are a new member or join us during the year or are just shy. If you are unable to find a partner either use Partner Finder on Pianola or contact the Host for the evening you want to play, who will arrange a partner for you.

**Substitutes** One substitute is allowed for any 4 game series. Email details of the substitution to the secretary at admin@southwairarapabridge.org.nz before the game involving the substitution begins. Swiss Pairs is the only 3 game series where substitutes are allowed

**Visitors are welcome at our club** and can play up to four times as a visitor before they join the club. Visitors and partners cannot win any series prizes but they are eligible for C points. Normal table money rules apply

**Table Seating** Seating direction is determined by the toss of a coin unless seating or moving rights have been approved by the Committee. The pair who win the toss sit North South

**Table Money** All players pay table money (except as approved in advance by the Committee) Ten session cards are available for \$40 otherwise payment is \$5.00 cash on the night of play. Ten Session Cards must be paid for online into our bank account which is 02 0608-0110363 00. Include TSC in the reference Field when you pay for your card.

**Club Subscriptions** If the SWBC is your home club the annual subscription is \$63.00, which includes a \$23.00 levy we collect on behalf of NZBridge. Your subscription is due before December 31st. You can pay online 02-0608-011106-00

### **During Play**

- South inputs the information into the bridge pads
- East verifies the Bridge Pad results
- West moves the boards when the Director asks EW to move
- North ensures the correct boards are played and placed in the right direction

### **At the end of the evening's play**

Each table ensures that:

- The stationery, table numbers and pencils are placed back in the plastic bags and put in the container
- The Table Cloths are neatly folded and put in the bag
- Rubbish bins are emptied and the bins and the side tables are put away

## **GUIDELINES FOR PLAYING ACCORDING TO THE RULES OF THE GAME**

The following are some guidelines for playing according to the laws of the game.

1. Before bidding begins, count the cards face down to ensure you have 13 cards.
2. If your partner opens 1 Club or 1NT, you must announce the meaning of that bid.
3. Any bid which your opponents might not understand should be alerted.
4. Use the STOP cards for jump bids. Place it in front of the left-hand opponent for 8 seconds.
5. Place the opening lead card face down, and check that your partner does not wish to ask any question about the auction before turning that card over
6. Please try to complete all boards on time.
7. We ask that you help your partner and your opponents to have an enjoyable time at the table when they play with you. Greet opponents when they come to your table. Please maintain a friendly attitude to everyone in the room. We are all here to enjoy the game.
8. The SWBC has adopted and will apply NZ Bridge's Zero Tolerance Policy. A copy of this can be found on the club noticeboard and in the NZBridge manual. A paper copy of the Manual can be found at the club and an electronic copy is available online at [nzbridge.co.nz](http://nzbridge.co.nz)

## MONDAY NIGHTS

On Monday Nights all Club Players are welcome to play but at least one member of the pair must be graded Novice or Junior. This rule does not apply for “Draw for Partners” nights.

**Pinehaven Championship Pairs** Pinehaven Championship pairs are played on the second Monday of each month between March and October. There are 8 games in total. You must play all games with the same partner (no substitutes allowed) The best 6 scores out of the 8 games are counted and the pair with highest score wins.

**Monday Individuals** There are 2 separate Individuals on Monday nights. One in January – 2 nights in total and Mr Feather’s Den Individual which is run throughout the year-6 nights in total. To be eligible to win a prize you must play each game with a different partner (you can play one game with your championship partner)

In both Individuals the person with the top score after the games have been played is the winner

**Monday Night Teams** Teams are made up of at least four players and must contain at least 2 players who are graded Novice or Junior. Each team must commit to playing the 3 weeks of this competition. You cannot withdraw your team once the competition has started

**Monday Night Duplicate pairs 3 night series** there are 9 three night series run throughout the year on Mondays. You can play with the same partner more than once but you can only win one series together. You cannot play with your

championship partner. You are eligible for C points every night you play.

**Welcome Pairs** (included in the 9 three night duplicate pairs series) in July there is series set aside to welcome beginners who have finished the lessons, into the club. We will be playing fewer boards and playing them at a slower pace in this series

**“Draw for Partner nights”** There are 2 “Draw for Partner” nights on Monday nights Family Night and the End of year Function. These are nights where the whole club, both Monday and Thursday players play together

## THURSDAY NIGHTS

### Blackwell Championship Pairs

Blackwell Championship Pairs are played on the second Thursday of each month between March and October (except in June when we are playing teams) there are 7 games in total. To be eligible to win this event you must play all games with the same partner (no substitutes allowed). The best 6 scores out of the 7 games are counted. The pair with highest score wins.

**Thursday Individuals** There are 2 separate Individuals on Thursday nights one in January – 3 nights in total and Vixen Burger Individual which is run throughout the year – 5 nights in total. To be eligible to win a prize you must play each game with a different partner (you can play one night with your championship partner) and in both individuals the person with the top score after all the games have been played is the winner.

**Thursday night teams** Teams are made up of at least 4 players of any grade. Each team must commit to playing the 4 weeks of this competition. Substitutes are allowed but you cannot withdraw your team once the competition has started.

**Thursday night duplicate pairs 3 Night Series** There are 8 duplicate pairs 3 night series run throughout the year. To be eligible for a prize you must play with a different partner for each series. You cannot play with your Championship Partner. You are eligible for C Points every night you play. The exceptions to this rule are the Swiss pairs and the Multigrade Club event.

**Swiss Pairs** Players commit in advance to playing this 3 night series – substitutes are allowed but a pair cannot withdraw from the competition . You cannot play with your championship partner but you can play with a partner from another series

**Three Night Multigrade event** This graded event is open to all Club Members and will be played over three Thursday nights in October and November We encourage all Monday night players to participate

In this event You play with a partner who is in a similar grade as yourself and compete against players who are the same or similar grade. You can play with your championship partner or any other partner you have previously played with or are scheduled to play with in a series. It is run over three nights and on the last night we have a prize giving for this event only. There are more details on our website

## CALLING THE DIRECTOR and APPEALS

The Laws of Bridge require that all games have a director. The main role of the director is to set up the room at the start of the game, so that we get a trouble-free evening. After that, the director's other main job is to keep things 'ticking over' so that we finish on time.

The third role of the director is to decide what to do if anything has gone wrong. This might be discovering that we have the wrong number of cards in our hand, or someone has made a mistake in entering a score. Other times the thing that goes wrong is what we refer to as an irregularity or an infraction. The most common irregularities or infractions are:

1. An Insufficient Bid
2. A call or bid out of turn, or out of rotation
3. A lead out of turn
4. A Revoke
5. A Fouled Board

If any of these happen at your table – you must call the director. It is the director's job to sort out problems in accordance with the laws of bridge. And in the case of Irregularities or Infractions, it is the director's job to help the players get a fair result.

There are many things that can go wrong. The Law Book is voluminous. If you have concerns about whether something is not quite right during the game, then you should call the director.

A director will then do one of two things – they will make a ruling straight away, or they may want to check with the Law Book or another experienced player before making a ruling. In both cases the Director will give directions regarding what you do next.

A director's ruling may not be challenged at the table. But the Law Book is voluminous for directors also, and they make mistakes. If you think the director's ruling is mistaken, not an unusual thing to happen at all, politely say to the director that you will exercise your right of appeal after the game is over. Then accept the director's ruling in the meantime and carry on.

Players have a right of appeal if they think the director got it wrong. If you wish to do this check that your partner agrees with your decision to appeal, and then let the director know that you wish to appeal. The Director will let you know what will happen next.

*If you need to call the director, please do so in a friendly polite way. If you can lift your hand into the air so that the director knows where the request came from, so much the better. Be prepared to wait a short while for the director to arrive.*

The SWBC is a Pianola Club. That means that you get:

- An email after every game with your results
- Access to all your results, either since you joined the club or since 2016
- Information on how well you did with each and every partner you have played with
- Information on how your declarer play compares to your defender play
- a full breakdown of how you did on each board of any game
- the ability to replay hands

A very useful feature of Pianola is “**Partner Finder**”. This lets you create advertisements that are emailed to other club members, telling them that you are seeking a partner.

## The X-Club

The SWBC is also a member of the X-Club.

The Club is a co operative of many clubs across New Zealand that play the same hands on both Monday and Thursday nights and pool their results. Later that night you can see how you scored compared to all the players in all those other clubs. You get a much better idea of how well you really played because small numbers of players can sometimes result in biased results.

After the X-Club has generated the results from a game, it sends out emails to players who are registered with the X-Club. About 40 club members get X-Club emails after a game, as well as the email they get from our club.


